

2024 INDIANA STATE GOLDEN GLOVES TOURNAMENT

WHAT: Indiana State Golden Gloves Tournament

WHEN: March 21, 28, April 4, 11, 18, and 25 Doors open 6:00pm, boxing starts 7:00pm

WHERE: Tyndall Armory 711 N Pennsylvania Street, Indianapolis, IN 46204

WEIGH IN: 4:30pm to 6:00pm each night the boxer is scheduled. No advanced weigh-ins.

PRE-BOUT PHYSICALS: 5:30p to 6:45pm each evening

GENERAL INFORMATION All boxers and coaches must be registered before the start of the tournament. We cannot make books out at the bouts. Remember your passbook is your ticket to get into the bouts. If you do not have your passbook, you will not get in the event for free, you will have to purchase a ticket.

DIVISIONS Open boxers are between the age of 18 and 40 and must be 18 by the first day of our tournament. Anyone can enter the open division in Golden Gloves, even those with no bouts but remember, once they enter the open division, they will always be open class boxers (all boxers who win the open championship for the state must have at least ten bouts to compete at Nationals).

Men 112, 125, 132, 139, 147, 156, 165, 176, 203, 203+

Women 110, 119, 125, 132, 139, 146, 154, 165, 178, 178+

DEADLINE Applications are due by February 18, 2024. Late applications will not be accepted.

PASSBOOKS: All boxers must have a Passbook to box in the Golden Gloves. Renewing boxers can go online to USA Boxing to register and print their membership (put it in your Passbook). New members must go to USA Boxing to register.

PHYSICALS: All boxers must have a physical form filled out and in the back of their passbook or your physical can be uploaded to your membership account with USA Boxing.. Physicals are good for 12 months.

NATIONALS: The National Tournament will be held this year from May 12 through May 18 in Detroit, MI. We will take the open class champions to the nationals as long as they have a bout at the state tournament and at least ten verified bouts total as an athlete . If you have a boxer who is unopposed and wants to go, they will have to pay their own way.



2024 Indiana Golden Gloves Fact Sheet

- 1) All participants of the 2024 Indiana Golden Gloves must be registered members in good standing with USA Boxing.
- 2) All athletes must have their current physicals uploaded to USA Boxing or attached to the back of their passbook. Note: The last page of the physical that is signed by the physician that states the athlete is “cleared for all sports without restrictions” must be present. Physicals are good for one year from the date signed by the physician.
- 3) All paperwork must be submitted to compete in the 2024 Indiana Gloves no later than February 18, 2024. Note: No late entries will be allowed after the deadline, **No Exceptions.**
- 4) In the event of a walk over the boxer receiving the walk over must make weight to be considered the winner.
- 5) Any athlete competing in the 2024 Indiana Golden Gloves Tournament that is not part of a registered USA Boxing Club must box as “unattached”.
- 6) Any athlete that has participated in any Mixed Martial Arts competition must box in the open division during the Indiana Golden Gloves Tournament.
- 7) All weight classes included in the 2024 Indiana Golden Gloves are established by Golden Gloves of America, Inc.

Open Division

- 1) Boxers in the Open Division must have a minimum of ten bouts to move on to the National Golden Gloves Tournament. Note: These bouts must be recorded in the USA Boxing “Matchtracker”.
- 2) Open boxers must have at least one bout in the 2024 Indiana Golden Gloves tournament for the Indiana Golden Gloves Franchise to cover expenses for the National Tournament. Note: In the event of a walk over the boxer can pay their own expenses for the National Tournament.
- 3) Open boxers must have their paperwork for the National Tournament completed and turned in no later than the Championship Night (April 25, 2024).
- 4) In an Olympic Trial year, you must be an American Citizen to box in the Open Division.
